Six Recurring Themes



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
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Member Center: The staff at Harmony Hall understands that the switch to the new Member Center has come with many challenges, specifically around user interface and data integrity. Feedback from members has helped to prioritize work to improve the Member Center.


Slow/no response to calls to BHS:

Increased resource investment in customer service has resulted in faster response time to leaders and members in the second half of 2022. The entire staff has also gotten involved in assisting with basic customer service needs, instead of relying solely on our four-person Community Care Team. This allows us to connect more regularly with our members and leaders.

RESOURCE: While we continue to field live calls, members can immediately communicate with staff members to answer their questions in real time via our recently launched Live Chat feature, located in the Member Center. Additionally, our Community Care Team has meeting times available to be scheduled every weekday via **Calendly.** Use Member Center's Live Chat or Calendly to contact Harmony Hall Staff directly at a time that is most convenient for you!

Questioning the value of BHS dues or belief that the hobby is too expensive


Six Recurring Themes





The cost of being a member may be a deterrent for some, a reason they can't participate, or a nonissue in terms of the value they personally receive. While the price of membership dues has stayed approximately the same over the past 10 years, we recognize a need to provide options for people to participate. This year, we will pilot new membership models and continue to provide free services to barbershop enthusiasts like high quality YouTube performances, free **Music Educators Guides and** free music, as well as free membership for BHS 50+ year members.

RESOURCE: To alleviate a bulk dues payment, BHS has an option for members to pay monthly versus annually. More importantly, we want members to believe their BHS membership is money well spent. The impact that our members contribute is invaluable, and can be seen in our most recent impact report.

Six Recurring Themes

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The BHS strategic vision supports singing communities for all people, while also preserving an all-male experience. With the newness of opening up the Society to more types of gathering and singing barbershop together, many folks felt this would force or require their experience to change. Your chapter does not have to change. The all-male experience is a critical part of Everyone in Harmony: that there will always be a safe space for men to express emotionality, expressiveness, and bonding with one another.

The all-male experience is a cherished part of the BHS history and will remain a highly valued experience.

RESOURCE: The Everyone in Harmony Workshop and Chapter Considerations Guide encourages chapters to meet the needs of their local community, whether that is staying single-gendered, or creating all-voice choruses. While chapters may choose to admit all persons to chapter membership, they are not compelled to alter existing membership admission policies.

The <u>Society Bylaws</u> and <u>Standard</u> <u>Chapter Bylaws</u> allow for a chapter's ability to determine its own membership requirements. Your chapter may ultimately decide to remain exactly as it has been. It may choose to host a number of different singing ensembles under one chapter: an all-male chorus, an all-female chorus, an all-female chorus, an all-voice chorus, or some combination thereof. The choice is yours exclusively, and you are not compelled to act by any date.




Making it easier to find music/learning tracks with better categorization to help find the right level of music for the SC

Six Recurring Themes

Over the past several years, the BHS music team has worked diligently to categorize music appropriately and to provide information and tools on how to search for music.

RESOURCE: The BHS music team created a search tool in shop.barbershop.org to help filter available published charts. Filters include ensemble type, genre, difficulty level, and tempo, among other filters. The pro search tips published in LiveWire, social media posts, and on our shop site "Sheet Music & Songbooks" page is a great resource for groups starting their search for music. BHS also created web seminars for music buyers available on our website that can assist groups in getting the right level of music for the group. A spreadsheet containing all BHSpublished music is available for download and custom sorting.

Six Recurring Themes

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
