## Responsibilities

- Work on measuring outcomes of portfolio of projects in 5 unique program areas: Merchandise & Music, Education, Membership, Outreach, and Corporate Activities
- Help identify key performance indicators and survey questions by facilitating meetings and one-on-one conversations around social impact
- Assist Project Coordinator in all five stages of project management: initiation, planning, execution, monitoring & controlling, and closing
- Work with organizations' local 501(c)(3)
- Work with organizational leaders on their business plans as well as provide training on how to create more sustainability and social impact through best practices in nonprofit management

### Requirements

The Barbershop Harmony Society is looking for an undergraduate student who is studying Social Entrepreneurship, Business Administration, Communications, Nonprofit Management, or similar fields. This person should be willing to perform high skill and low skill tasks required- from strategic planning to capturing notes, for example. A person that loves making a difference in the lives of others and applying business practices in a non profit setting will enjoy this internship. This person should be comfortable leading and working both independently and within project teams.
