**Life Membership:** 20 times the current regular rate. Life members never pay Society dues again, but pay district and chapter dues annually.

**Youth 1:** \$10 Enrollment fee, and \$0 dues for the first year only. Youth members must be under 26 years old.

**Youth 2:** Any member under 26 years old who is a 2nd year + member.

**Senior Members (SN, SL):** Any man who is age 70 or older, and also has 10 years of service in the Society.

**50 Year Members:** \$0 Society dues. Districts vary in pricing. (A 50-year member is one who has paid for 50 years of membership.)

**Notes:**

\* Some districts award a discount for first-time members. The chapter secretary should verify with his District Secretary before NOT charging the district dues.

\*\* Far Western District dues prices are divided into Non-Hawaii/Hawaii. Hawaii members pay 1/2 the FWD rate for respective categories.

\*\*\* Ontario District dues are configured on the CANADIAN dollar, not the USD.
