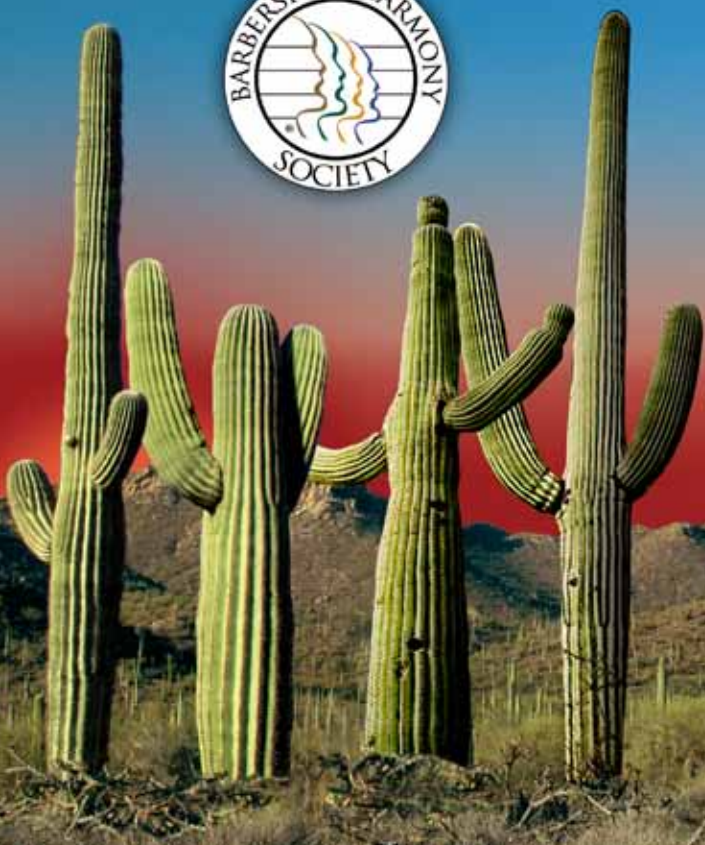

## Joe Cerutti, Emcee & Director

Joe Cerutti is Master Director of the 115-member Alexandria Harmonizers (MAD), currently ranked 5th internationally, and is also director of the Pride of Baltimore (SAI), a 115-member women's a cappella chorus. This week, Joe will be installed as a Society Board member.

Joe holds a Bachelor's degree in Music Education from Five Towns College and a Master's degree in Choral Conducting from Boston University. While in Boston, Joe taught music at South Boston's



Monument High School, and conducted the concert chorus and women's chorale at Boston University.

Joe is a life member of the Barbershop Harmony Society, a charter member of NCCO, and a member of ACDA, MENC, and ChorusAmerica. He is a certified Society Music judge and the youngest of the nine men in Society history to earn Master Director certification. Joe was also the lead singer for New York's Most Dangerous Big Band, a 30-piece swing band that has performed for the likes of Bette Midler and Kelsey Grammar. He was an auditioned participant of the Carnegie Hall Choral Institute, founded by the late Robert Shaw. Joe serves as immediate past chairman of the Society's Chorus Director Development Committee and has served as faculty and coach for several district colleges, conductor roundtables, as well as at Harmony University.

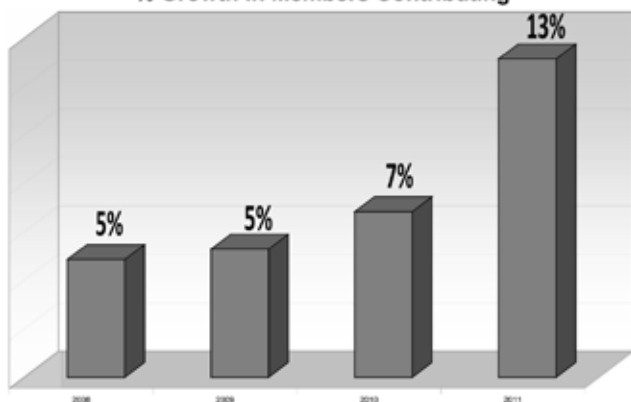

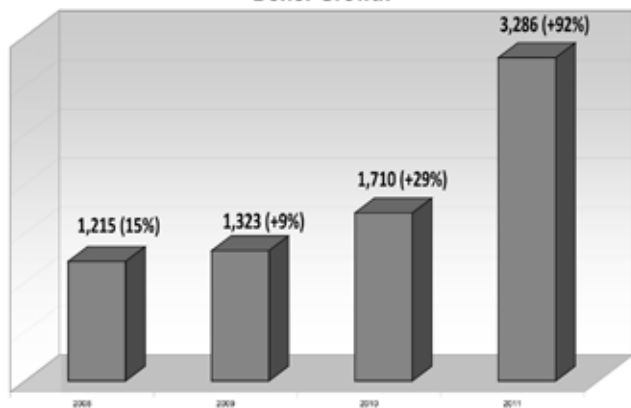

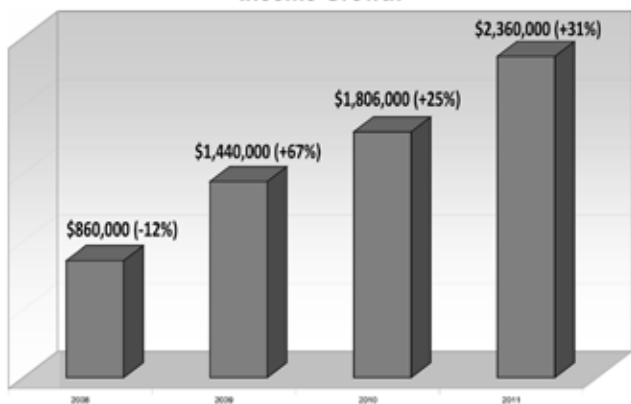
**% Growth in Members Contributing**



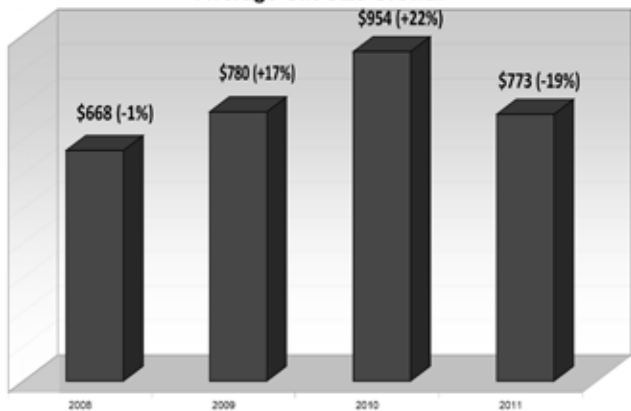
**Donor Growth**
